### DON'T BE AFRAID TO TRY!

- You might surprise yourself!
- We aren't seeking perfection.
- Don't be intimidated by the idea that grants should be innovative and inventive.
- You can submit multiple Grant Proposals or be a participant in multiple grant requests.
- Grants funded for other campuses can be funded for yours, too!

## WRITING YOUR PROPOSAL

You don't have to be a Pulitzer Prize winning author to write a GREAT grant! Just answer the questions in the Application fully and from the heart. Most grants should only take a few hours to plan and complete. Grant Writing Tips:

- Write your Grant Proposal as if speaking to an 8th grade student. Keep it simple!
- Don't use educational jargon, acronyms, or concepts that require an educational background to understand.
- Don't get consumed with one aspect of the Application - grants are awarded based on full consideration of MANY factors.
- Pre-plan your Application responses before actually completing the Google Form. Ask someone to proofread your answers for clarity and errors.

#### REMEMBER!

### **Keep it ANONYMOUS**

Don't include identifying information in the Application (e.g., name, campus, etc.)

#### **Keep it ACADEMICALLY-FOCUSED**

LEF wants to fund grants that will make a true educational impact on LISD students. Focus your grant ideas on those that will take learning to a higher level or illuminate grade-level concepts.

#### **Keep it SINCERE**

Speak from the heart. Tell us how this project or experience will have an impact on the students you serve!
